Welcome to Winterton Running Club

The Club was formed in 1991 and is affiliated to the English Athletics

The Club is primarily a road running club, catering for all ages and abilities over the age of 16; we also cater for a variety of distances.

The Club meets twice weekly on **Sunday at 9.30 am** and **Wednesday at 6.30 pm** at Winterton Village Hall, West Street, Winterton North Lincolnshire.

RULES

1. Club colours are blue shorts/ blue vest with a gold horizontal band carrying the club name and logo.
2. Kit can be ordered through the club secretary or direct to (Fastrax www.fastraxrunning.co.uk Tel 01943 601581).
3. Club kit must be worn in official races.
4. Non members will be allowed to visit club sessions on two occasions before joining.
5. The club organises a number of events, any club member can be co – opted to help with the planning or actual event in question.
6. Slower / New members will not be left to run alone. ALL club members to volunteer to run with and accompany the slow or new member.
7. Club members are responsible for informing the secretary of their times from any official race.

8. Reflective bibs MUST be worn on dark evenings. One warning will be given. It is the members responsibility to supply and run in reflective clothing.
9. Members MUST run safely on the roads for the benefit of other road users. It is the responsibility of the individual to run safely.
10. The club accepts no liability for injury or loss or damage to valuables belonging to individuals as members of the club or guests of the club...
11. All notices appertaining to Club rules etc will always be displayed on the club notice board.
12. All Grievances must be put in writing to the Club secretary who will then bring it to the attention of the committee. The grievance will be reported back to the person in question within one calendar month.
13. London Marathon Procedure:-
 - The draw is restricted to those members who have entered and failed to gain a place.
 - The member has had to be a paid up member for a minimum of 12 months.
 - A draw will take place amongst those members who have not done the event before.
 - A draw will take place for all members providing that they have entered the race and failed to gain entry.
 - If there are more than two members who fulfill the criteria then you can not enter the draw if you have gained the club entry the previous year.
 - There will be an open draw to all if there are no members who satisfy any of the above.
 - There will be no differentiation between first and second claim members, however if they receive the club entry they MUST run in WRC colours and their results will be referred to as WRC.
14. The AGM is held on the last Wednesday in January.
